2020-21 & 2021-2022

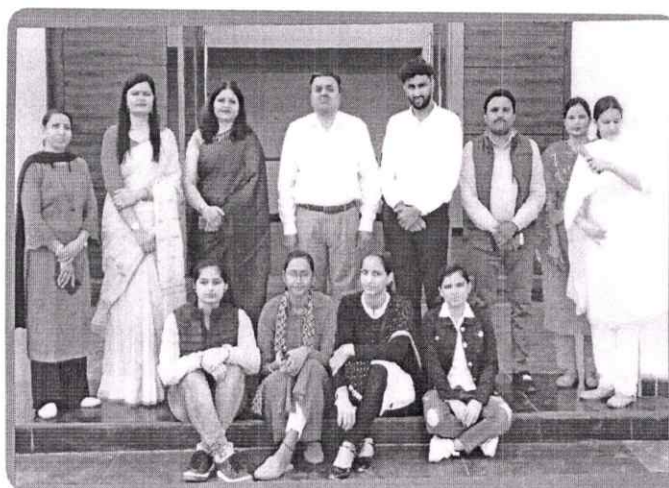

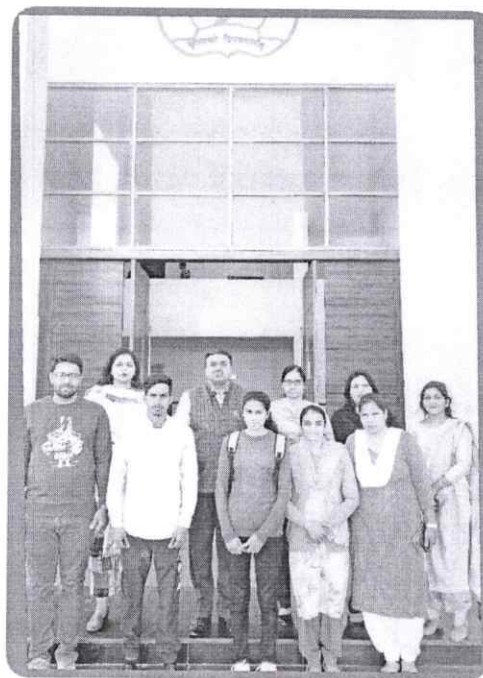

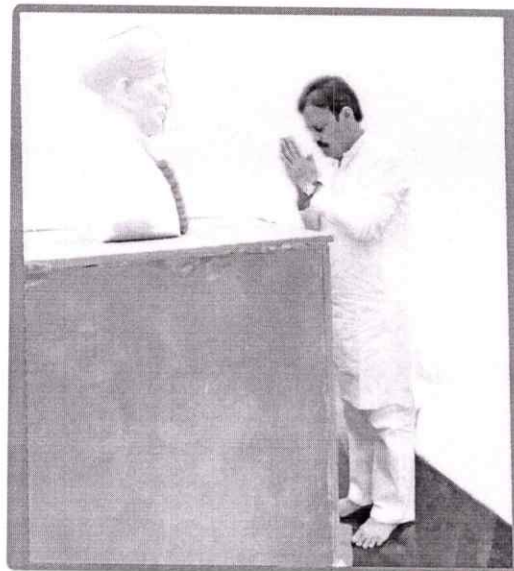

CAREER COUNSELLING AND PLACEMENT CELL

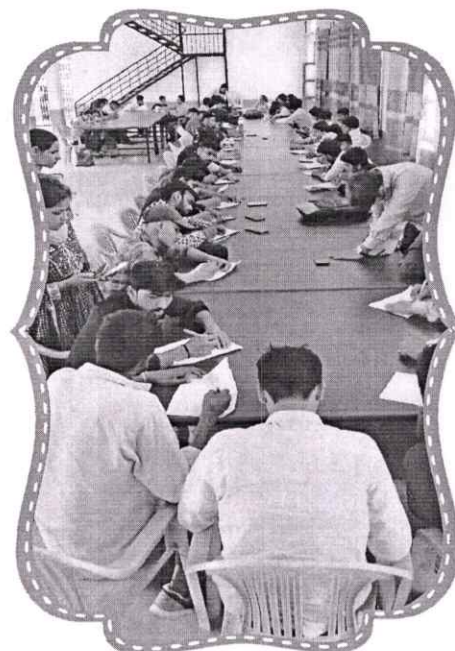

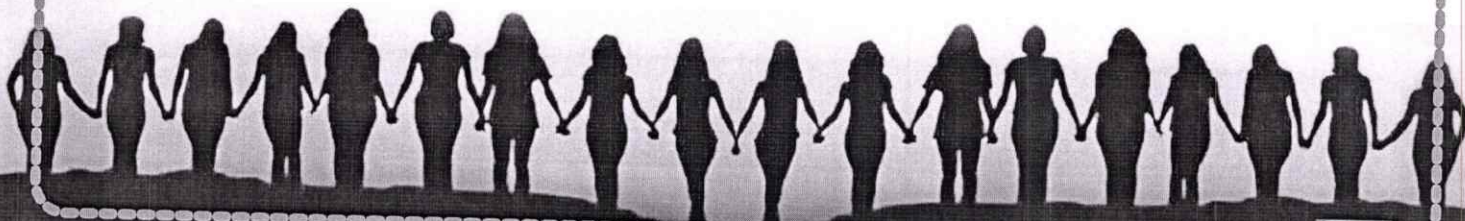


2021-2022

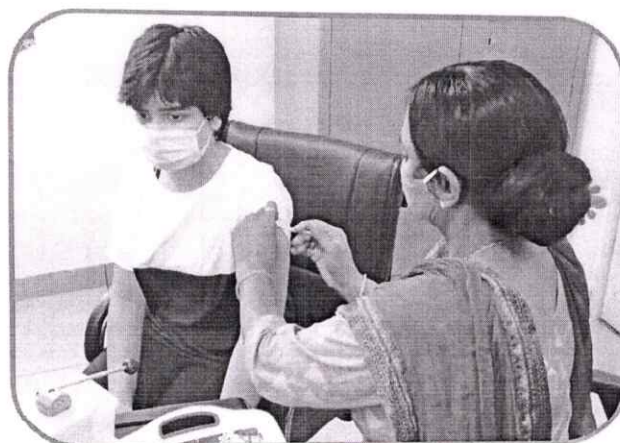
