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Gender Audit: An Introduction

A. Introduction of the Institution:

With the dawn of independence, there was a dire need to improve opportunities for higher education for the underprivileged sections of society. Ch. Tika Ram, founder of the institute, was inspired by the same spirit when he established Chhotu Ram Arya College in 1951 on the death anniversary of Ch. Chhotu Ram. The institute has been following the ideals of Ch. Tika Ram and Ch. Chhotu Ram, and its main objectives are to uplift the down-trodden, and provide quality education to one and all. Chhotu Ram Arya College is known for its great achievements, the students achieve tremendous success in games, cultural activities, and academics. Recently, the college authorities decided to launch different types of courses, including professional ones for the benefit of society. This is a step forward to academic excellence and towards providing the opportunity to the students and teachers. The campus comprises modern lecture theatres, computer labs with more than 120 computers, and roundthe-clock internet. The campus provides blanket wireless services (wifi) in the institute. One centralized fully AC soundproof Theatre & Multipurpose Hall with a sitting capacity of 200 Students has been furnished with ultra-modern latest techniques. College library is one of the best libraries in the state, attracting voracious readers, has a rare collection of more than 30000 books in a unique feature besides 2000 books for competitive examinations. C R A College prides itself by possessing a rare distinction of having a highly qualified, dedicated and enthusiastic staff with doctorates, M.Phil. and different prestigious awards. In addition to conventional teaching, more stress is laid on imbibing moral and ethical characters, career planning and guidance, and co-curricular activities such as Cultural activities, NSS and Sports etc.

B. Context:

When the institution was established, the issue of gender awareness was not much of a concern especially in a city surrounded by rural background. This awareness became a major parameter for institutional governance, so the institutional leaders stepped forward to ensure gender equality. Gender sensitive approach aims at opening, reconstructing and broadening expectations and behavioural models related to gender awareness. Gender sensitive structures respond equally to men and women's specific interests without any presumption based on stereo typical mind-set.

C. Gender Audit

The basic assumption of gender audit in an educational institution is that public policies, opinions, and expectations impact differently on female and male learners. The purpose of gender audit is to lead to positive changes which contribute to an increase in gender equality. It is a tool to check and assess the institutionalization of gender equality into organizations, including in their policies, programs, projects, provision of services and participation etc. Without gender audit, we cannot analyse whether the college has a good gender balance, and what the Institution is doing to improve the status of women in general and the representation of women's voice in particular. It tries to see whether college follows government rules, policies and actions formulated for up-gradation of gender equality in institute and society as well. The Gender Audit tries to access the impact of its current and proposed policies on gender equality.

D. Phases of Gender Audit

Gender audit follows different phases by analyzing:

• The gender- specific objectives of the institute and how much the institute fosters gender equality internally within its organizational, managerial structure and internal work, and whether these contribute to gender equality in the organization.

• Whether gender equality is mainstreamed in the general objectives of the institutional policy in order to guarantee that they contribute to close gender gaps, ensure that women and men benefit equally or in accordance with their gender needs and those inequalities are not perpetuated.

• How gender equality is mainstreamed into the implementation phase of the policy, programme or project by exploring to what extent gender equality is mainstreamed in high-level policy objectives and priorities, and further assess to what extent policy intentions are carried out in specific initiatives.

• How the relative progress made in gender mainstreaming contributes to capacity building and collective organizational ownership for gender equality initiatives, and sharpens organizational learning on gender.

• Finally, a gender audit of the evaluation phase investigates whether targets and indicators include a gender perspective both in terms of sex-ratio data and progress towards gender equality.

E. Functioning of the Gender Audit:

• To join hands with IQAC, Anti-ragging Committee, Women Cell, Discipline Committee and Internal Complaint Committee for creation of gender sensitization and gender equality. • Initially, efforts are made to know and analyze gender perception among students, staff members and administration in the campus.

• To prepare a road map for gender audit action after due consideration and suggestions from different committees.

• To start gender action, first of all, the gender balance of students, teaching and non-teaching staff members and administration in the college has to be known and analysed.

• To ensure the planning of different activities regarding the gender awareness in and outside the campus.

F. Gender Audit Methods:

For organizational transformation the institute has to focus on gender integration in all important dimensions of organization. Gender Integration Structure has to be created to conduct gender audit.

• First gender audit focuses on organizational culture by exploring norms, customs, beliefs and codes of behavior in an organization that support gender equality – how people behave and what behaviors are rewarded or rejected.

• Secondly, gender audit surveys institutional mechanisms by which a college determines the extent of integrating gender equality in its programs and organizational structures.

• Next, the audit evaluates procedural competence including level of commitment, qualifications and skills people hold to carry out the practical aspects of gender integration for enhanced program quality.

• Last but not least the audit investigates the initiatives in which the governance within the college at different levels engages their subordinates and students to successfully create gender awareness. How the higher authorities communicate and demonstrate their support, leadership, enthusiasm for and commitment to working toward gender equality in the college.

G. Constitution of Gender Audit Committee:

The Gender Audit undertaken by Chairman, Vice Chairman, IQAC, external and internal Committee Members, intended to scrutinize the gender balance and gender equality within the institution and its practices

H. Gender Balance within the Institution:

The logic behind the gender audit is the rationale that traditionally women have been suppressed under the domination of patriarchal social structure due to which they have lesser access to resources and opportunities provided by institutions and organizations. This results in lesser competence among women which in turn hampers their empowerment and access to development initiatives. Gender audit is the steppingstone to achieve gender equity which requires that girls and women should be provided with a full range of activity and program choices that meet their needs, interests and experiences. Therefore, some activities may be the same as those offered to boys and men, some may be altered, and some may be altogether different.

The first requisite of Gender audit is to know and analyze gender balance, which means the existence of a fair ratio of male and female representation within the institution in terms of number and participation of students in the various programmes as well as within the staff structure.

I: Objectives of Gender Sensitization and Anti Sexual Harassment Programmes:

- Joining hands with various committees like Anti-ragging, Internal Complaints, Discipline Committee and Women Development Cell.
- To keep gender equality upright in the college, providing facilities to girl students and female staff members.
- To create awareness about the gender discrimination and problems of women in and outside the campus.
- The institute shall take effective measures for the safety and security of all students, specifically for girl students.
- There must be an accessible, active, unbiased and confidential Grievance Redressal Cell.
- To develop and enhance the self-confidence and self-esteem of girl students, women faculty and staff in the college.
- Overall personality development programs shall be organized, which will develop confidence in the members of the institution.
- To protect girl students from eve teasing and for the same posters to be exhibited at focal places in and around the college.
- Certified consultants and professionals to be invited to take care of personal development and confidence building among students.
- Organizing programs to build confidence and instil leadership qualities in all students.

J: Initiatives of Gender Sensitization and Anti Sexual Harassment Programme:

The following initiatives and provisions have been undertaken by the College for the convenience and safety of girl students:

- A. **Safe Entrance:** The safe entrance with female peon is one of the safety measures for girls.
- B. Ladies Staff Room: Well-furnished rooms with attached washrooms are provided for staff members.
- C. Girls Common Room: There is a separate Girls Common Room and silence is maintained for them to study.
- D. Girls Washroom: Separate Girls' washrooms are provided at two different places in the college with ample water supply and proper maintenance.
- E. **Drinking Water:** Water coolers and water purifiers have been provided for boys and girls in the College campus.
- F. Library: Without any consideration of gender and category differences library is accessible for all.
- G. **CCTV monitoring devices**: There are CCTV monitoring devices installed at different locations within the campus.
- H. Canteen: There is a safe and easy access to the canteen for girls.

K: Committees involved in Gender Sensitization and Anti Sexual

Harassment Initiatives: The College has established a number of committees to aid girl students and ladies' staff. These committees include:

a) Anti-Ragging Committee: In order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging the College has formed an Anti-Ragging Committee. The students in distress owing to ragging related incidents can approach the Committee. The Committee comprises Anti-Ragging Squad, and student Representatives. The Principal of the College is the Chairperson of the Anti-Ragging Committee. Our college publishes its regulations in the prospectus and announces that Ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has notified regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in educational institutions.

b) Discipline Committee: The College has formed a Discipline Committee.

The students in distress owing to Discipline related incidents can contact the committee. The Principal of the College is the Chairperson of the Discipline Committee. The college publishes its regulations to maintain discipline in college in the prospectus.

c) Women Development Cell: Women Empowerment and Gender Equality are the most important requirements for the upliftment and progress of our nation. In the effort to make institute a strong platform of gender sensitization, the Women Development Cell was constituted. The cell has both the faculty and nonteaching of the College as its members and works with an aim to create a gender sensitized community within campus as well as in the society. It has been organizing various skill enhancements, academic, technical, medical, cultural and social events for the upliftment of women and promotion of the importance of gender equality in society through the College students.

d) **NSS for Girls:** Our institute has NSS to sensitize students towards societal issues and community services, activities of which are mainly carried out by the students. The NSS units provide a suitable environment for taking up a career in the social services. The girls are trained and motivated for all kinds of social work in the field. They are motivated to serve the society.

e) **Gender Champions:** Becoming a student representative enables the student to develop and strengthen leadership skills, connect with various internal and external issues and problems, assist fellow students, share experiences and participate in college events for the administrative development.

f) Equal Opportunity Cell: This cell ensures that every student irrespective caste, creed and religions get equal opportunity. College does not discriminate at at any level.

g) Internal Complaint Committee: As per the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act and Rule 2013, the college has constituted an Internal Complaint Committee (ICC). Having raised the bar of responsibility and accountability in the Vishaka Guidelines, the Supreme Court placed an obligation on workplaces, institutions and those in positions of responsibility, to uphold working women's fundamental right to equality and dignity at the workplace. Three key obligations were imposed on institutions to meet that standard, namely-Prohibition, Prevention and Redress. Consistent with the Vishaka judgment, the Act aspires to ensure women's right to workplace equality, protection from sexual harassment through compliance with the above mentioned three elements. It is important to note that the Act provides a civil remedy to women in addition to other laws that are currently in force.

Progress towards Gender Equity

The institution strictly follows the concept of gender equality and gender equity detailed by United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESDOC), "Gender equality, equality between men and women...does not mean that women and men have to become the same, but that their rights, responsibilities and opportunities will not depend on whether they were born male or female. Gender equity means fairness of treatment for men and women according to their respective needs. This may include equal treatment or treatment that is

different, but which is considered equivalent in terms of rights, benefits, obligations, and opportunities." Our institution recognizes that women and men have different needs and potential and that these differences should be identified and addressed well in time in a manner that rectifies the imbalances between the sexes.

Chhotu Ram Arya College organizes a number of activities to empower women, these include engaging, sensitizing and making all administration, staff and students of the institution aware of gender equality. Our college organizes seminars, conferences, guest lectures, workshops and awareness programmes on various women related issues to equip them with wide range of skills and knowledge for the betterment of self, institution and society. The College also focuses on empowering and strengthening the confidence of girl students to be the future women leaders, perfect home makers and professions. Regular sessions are organized at various levels to instil self-confidence, develop ethical values and make the girl students realize and utilize their true potential. A t the same time these activities sensitize male staff members to change their mindset and accept women as their equally competent counterparts.

Findings of Gender Audit:

Gender Audit was conducted on 8th and 9th August 2022. The team reviewed and analyzed the complete environment of college and came to the conclusion that the college has been running in an environment where everyone feels free to access to a full range of opportunities. The college provides a platform to achieve the social, psychological and physical benefits that come from representing, participating and leading in administration, curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities. The college always concentrates on students' academic performance along with their overall personality development. Observing gender equality, the girls are provided with various facilities. The two NSS units for boys and girls have been meticulously focusing on outstanding achievements of the girls. The lectures and workshops have been held on 'Prevention of Sexual Abuse and Safety of Girls Students', 'Health and Hygiene,' 'Awareness & Legal Aspects of Sexual Abuse', 'Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (prohibition, prevention and redressal), etc. Anti-ragging Committee and Internal Complaints Committee have already been formed in the college. Our girl students have achieved grand success in the field of Academics, Cultural Activities and Sports. Their participation in Youth Festival and various competitions has brought laurels and fame to them as well as the College. The analysis of the responses of students and staff members with regard to programme, planning and design in college and its activities have shown that everyone feels that the gender equity in policies, programmes of the college is adequate.

The subtle qualities of gender audit in the Institution revealed the following notable points:

- Basic sanitation facility in the form of separate toilets for the students and staff is provided in the common area. Separate toilets for male and female faculty members, girl and boy students are available.
- A Ladies Staff Room with attached toilet is provided on the 1st Floor of the main building.
- Girls Common Room adjoining to Ladies Staff Room is allotted.
- There are CCTV monitoring devices installed at different locations within the campus especially within the Library and major entry and exit points.
- There is a Women Cell that conducts Gender Sensitization programmes regularly for the students.
- All the main Committees are functional and supportive to each other to encourage gender sensitization in and outside the campus.
- Student's strength particularly girls' strength is increasing in PG programmes. More girls are enrolling for higher studies.
- Among ad hoc teaching staff the strength of females is higher than that of males.
- Women have representation in governing body of college.

SUGGESTIONS FOR ENHANCEMENT:

In the coming years, our institute aims to :

- Introduce the presence and acceptance of LG B T Q community.
- Increase the Awareness programs on the presence and inclusion of Third Gender.
- Increase the participation of girl students in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- Increase the participation of female staff to decision making bodies.
- Organize more co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for students and staff members.
- Motivate students to change their mindset regarding the stereo typical gender specific roles.
- Organize awareness programs on Legal Rights of Women.
- Introduce self-employment training in different subjects.

Conclusion:

The audit and analysis show that gender equity goals and objectives have been included in all the policies, programmes governance of the college. The students, teaching and non-teaching staff also reported that they have no problems related to gender criterion. Gender Audit Team analyzed that gender equality and gender sensitivity is encouraged by administration and staff of the college and they do have gender sensitive behavior. It is found that the college has a lot of strengths and opportunities to develop good gender balance. The weaknesses can be overcome with gradual changes in value set up. Doubtless, the enrolment of girls from all sections of society is increasing and there are no gender issue complaints. With the strong will power and commitment to gender justice, the College would certainly make a mark in the society.
